

Charles N. Silver – WAE Inspector

Charles Silver served as a Foreign Service public diplomacy officer dividing his time between East Asia and Western Europe. He served in Jakarta on two separate assignments, the American Institute in Taiwan, Beijing, and Copenhagen. In Washington he worked in the Bureaus of East Asian and Pacific Affairs, European and Eurasian Affairs, and Public Affairs. He most recently retired from his position as Deputy Assistant Inspector General, having previously served as a Senior Inspector in OIG. Prior to joining OIG, he was Director of the Office of Policy, Programs and Evaluation in the Bureau of International Information Programs.

A former member of the Senior Foreign Service with the rank of Minister Counselor, Charles studied at the City University of New York and Yale University. Before joining the Foreign Service he was a Peace Corps volunteer in Malaysia. His languages are Indonesian, Chinese, and Danish.
